Shea 2017: Seeds of Change





Over 400 international stakeholders from across the shea value chain gathered in Cotonou, Benin to discuss the latest developments in the shea industry. From small women's groups to global brands to government representatives, participants were able to learn from panel sessions, network in the business-to-business forum, and showcase their products at the exhibit.

This year's theme: Seeds of Change embodied the innovations that GSA members are planting including empowering women, expanding markets, preserving shea parklands and building public – private partnerships.

On behalf of the President of the Republic of Benin, Patrice Talon, the Minister of Planning and Development gave opening remarks. Other distinguished guests who spoke at the opening ceremony include US Ambassador to Benin Lucy Tamlyn, GSA President Moumouni Konate, and CEO of Natura Cosmetics, Gilles Adamon.

Shea Based Cosmetics: Green is the New Black



The Global Shea Alliance hosted the second annual European Conference on April 3rd in the UK. The event was organized under the theme "Shea Based Cosmetics: Green is the New Black," and was held at The Body Shop Corporate Offices in Croydon, England.



During the first panel speakers discussed the wide range of shea derivatives and their uses in cosmetic formulations. The participants had the opportunity to better understand the trends in the growth of this important under-valued but sometimes ingredient, and the considerations for using it in existing and new applications.

The second panel described the vital contribution of shea to women's empowerment in Africa and how biodiversity and environmental protection are being advanced in shea parklands.

The third panel explored ways to engage consumers through media and targeted messaging on shea.

The event concluded with interactive tables where attendees held in-depth discussions with sector experts on a variety of topics including: biodiversity, shea trade flows, and women's empowerment.

The agenda included updates on follow-up items from the November 2016 meeting, 2016 annual sustainability report and general assembly presentation review.







Sustainable Shea Initiative

Benin Stakeholders Meeting

On December 14th, the Global Shea Alliance held a one-day forum in Parakou, Benin to develop a country-level strategy for implementing the Sustainable Shea Initiative. Over 25 stakeholders from across the shea value chain attended the forum. The strategy incorporated specific challenges facing the shea industry in Benin including business development trainings for women cooperatives and the need to engage with more private sector stakeholders.





Burkina Faso Stakeholders Meeting

On February 21st, the Global Shea Alliance held a one-day forum in Ouagadougo, Burkina Faso to develop a country level national strategy for implementing the Sustainable Shea Initiative. Over 35 participants attended this forum to contribute to the strategy. The participants discussed the challenges facing the shea industry in Burkina Faso with a focus on the importance of securing access to tree populations for women.







International Events and Promotion

Personal Care and Products Council (PCPCP)

On February 28th, the GSA presented to 200 members of the PCPC that are comprised of large beauty brands and cosmetic suppliers. Facilitated by a beauty editor from Vogue Italia, GSA member representatives from Burt's Bees, Pagsung Women's Association, and Eu'Genia Shea provided perspectives of women's groups, cosmetic brands, and the benefits of GSA membership.






Sustainable Food Lab
