Terms of Reference – Carbon Consultant

Established in 2011, The Global Shea Alliance (GSA) is a nonprofit industry association based in Accra, Ghana. We currently have 560 members from 35 countries including food and cosmetic brands, suppliers, women's groups, and non-profit organizations. Through public- private partnerships, the GSA promotes industry sustainability, quality practices and standards, and demand for shea in food and cosmetics.

The GSA is currently assessing the opportunity to conduct a carbon-credit project, and seeks a consultant to conduct a feasibility study.

Activities

The consultant(s) will produce a report detailing the following elements:

- 1. Reference at least 10 potential methodologies from the 3 main private carbon standards (Verra, Plan Vivo and Gold Standard) as well as public standards (e.g. World Bank) that are applicable to the shea value chain
- 2. Determine which methodology (ies) is the most appropriate based on data availability in the selected countries (publicly available data as well as private data available through shea stakeholders)
- Provide a short report on the private carbon-credit landscape in the selected countries (e.g. legal framework, scope of allowed private carbon credits, authorization mechanisms etc.)
- 4. Provide a list of potential commercial market for carbon sale
- 5. Advise on a strategy around private sector carbon projects in the shea landscapes

Selected countries to be covered include: Benin, Burkina Faso, and Ghana
